

### Record check, contractors

Under current security protection legislation (SFS 1996:627) persons who gain admission, or access, to sensitive information on important objects such as nuclear facilities, are subject to security clearance.

Security clearance refers to reliability and is aimed at protecting these facilities against espionage, sabotage and terrorist attack. It is based on testimonials, references, interviews and record checks to establish that there are no adverse entries in police and Swedish Security Service records. Follow-ups are made for the period during which admission is granted, or access to sensitive information continues.

Processing of questions concerning security clearance is subject to separate instructions. The data is treated as confidential.
